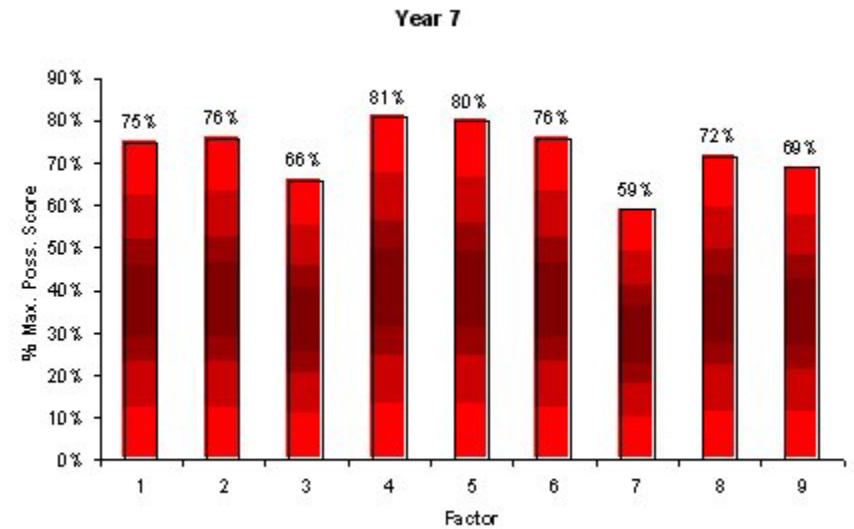
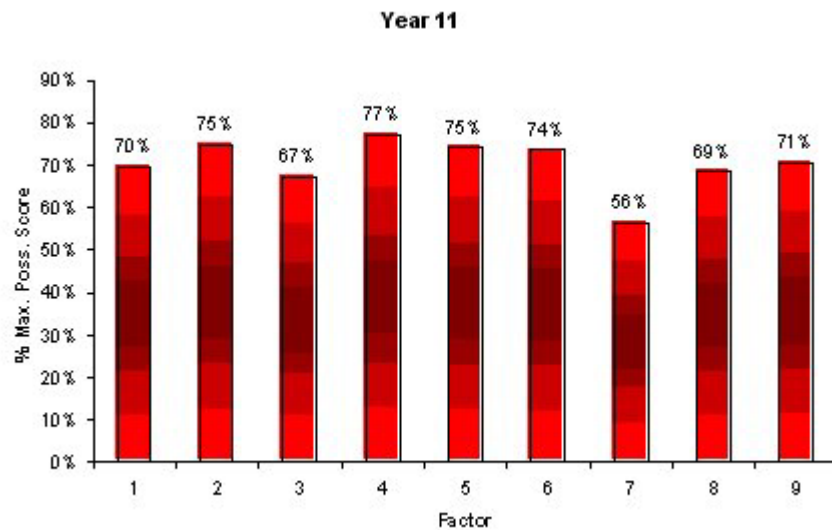


SECONDARY PASS STANDARDISATION FINDINGS

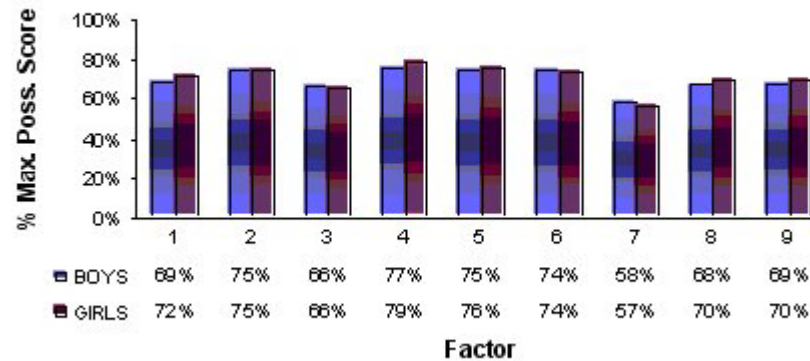
Here are some of examples of attitude findings for Year 7-11 pupils. Please note that although these give a flavour of some of the early data, our actual standardisation profiles are regularly updated in line with new norms.

YEAR GROUP

Children differ significantly across year groups on all attitude measures



PASS Factor Comparison by Gender



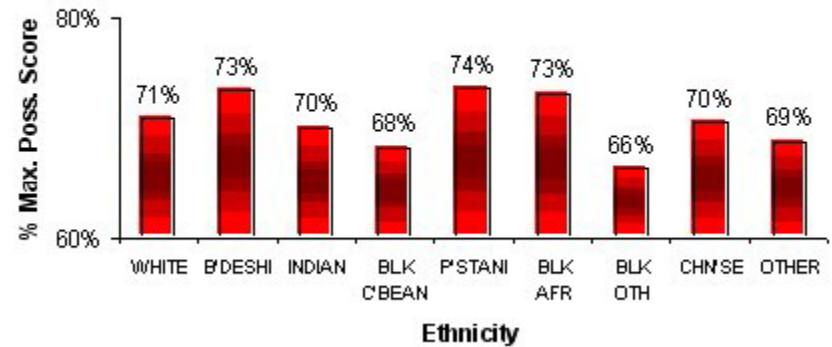
GENDER

Female pupils show significantly more positive attitudes and self concepts than boys. This is true for all P.A.S.S. factors except work ethic and confidence in learning where gender differences are negligible.

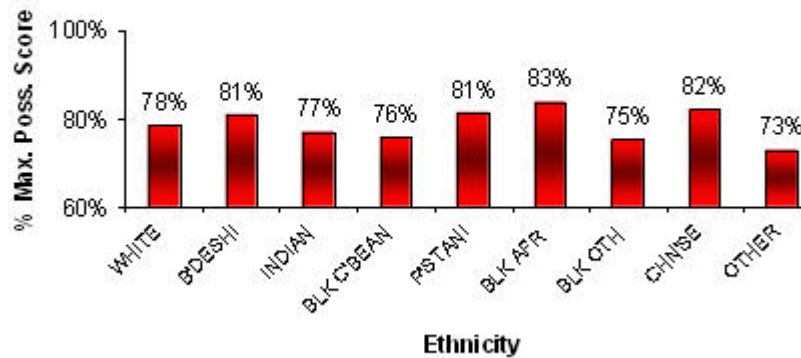
ETHNICITY

For secondary school children ethnic grouping appears to significantly effect pupil attitudes on all P.A.S.S. factors except Attitudes to Teachers and General Work Ethic. Some examples of findings for ethnicity are included below.
